

Chapter 1

EDITORIAL

It is gateful to say that valuable messages are received from Minister, Principal Secretary and Engineer-in-Chief in this publication. Their words will inspire the PWD personnel in serving the people of Mizoram.

During this year, the volume of Expenditure as a whole is Rs 894.58 Cr. A total of Rs 754.73 cr was received from the State, Central Govt. and other external Aided Agencies. There are other expenditures of Rs 75.53 cr from PMGSY works and Rs 56.38 cr from National Highway Fund with its revenue of Rs 7.94 Cr.



1. ORGANISATION

Engineer-in-Chief is the head of the Department as a whole and having three Chief Engineers on zonal basis i.e. Roads, Buildings & Highways. Engineer-in-Chief in the Office is assisted by one Chief Engineer (Planning) and one Chief Architect. There are 9 circle offices and one PIU each headed by SEs. There are 29 working Divisions headed by EEs and 84 Sub-Divisional Offices headed by SDOs.

2. RSMP

For implementation of the Road Sector Modernization Plan activities, RSMP - Working Group Committee chaired by the Engineer-in-Chief, PWD was formed on 7th May, 2015 with 10 members in the Committee. For effective implementation of the activities, 5 RSMP – Sub Group Committees were again formed with each Sub-Groups having specific tasks.

Under the RSMP activities, installation of Video Conferencing system in E-in-C Mini Conference Room and distribution of Video Conferencing hardware facilities in 17 PWD Offices have already been carried out while several activities are still more to come for implementation.

3. Highlight of Achievements :

Some of the achievements may be summerised as below;

A. ROAD SECTOR:

- i) Improvement and Renovation of Roads within Aizawl and District Hqrs are done under NEDP Programme. While Buarpui-Bunghmun and Phairuang-Thenhlum/ Zawlpui roads are in good progress,
- ii) 32.85 kms resurfaced, 273 kms patch repair and some retaining wall/ Culvert/Pavement are taken up under Maintenance Fund,
- iii) Since inception of PMGSY Scheme in Mizoram, a total of 273 different roads for a length of 3507.86 kms have been covered benefitting 192 nos. of habitations, 37nos of roads for a length of 704.67 kms have been completed upto black-topping stage benefitting 42 nos. of habitations,
- iv) Muallungthu-Khumtung road is under completion stage and some other road constructions are in good progress under NABARD Scheme,
- v) Improvement of Saitual-Saichal and Bairabi-Zamuang are completed under NEC Scheme,
- vi) 3 Bailey Bridges are physically completed, Suspension Bridge over R. Chhimtuipui and Chuhvel-Sihthiang road are also completed under NLCPR,
- vii) Under ISC, Tuipuibari-West Kawnpui is in good progress,
- viii) Under CRF, Strengthening of Aizawl-Reek and R. Tuipui-Biate road are completed,

B. HIGHWAY SECTOR :

i) Realignment, Geometrical improvement, IRQP and 2-laning of various roads are under taken under Highway original works and Periodical Repair works,

ii) Under SARDP-NE, widening to 2-laning, realignment and geometrical improvement of South Mizoram and MultiModal project works are taken up in good progress,

C. PIU :

- i) Under Mizoram State Roads II Regional Transport Connectivity (World Bank) Project, Improvement and Up- gradation of Champhai - Zokhawthar (27.25 Km), Chhumkhum -Chawngte (41.53 Km), Tlabung - Kawrpuichhuah (12.00 Km) are taken up and in good progress.
- ii) While Junction NH 44A (originating) passing through Chungtlang-Darlung-Buarpui, Buarpui -Thenzawl – Buarpui, Chawngte including bridge to Bungtlang South up to Multimodal road junction and Zawlpui –Phairuangkai are under DPR completion stage.
- ii) Whereas under ADB Scheme, Intermediate Lane of Serchhip Buarpui road is in good progress having overall physical progress of 28%

D. BUILDING SECTOR :

Prominent buildings like Indoor Stadium at Lunglei, Minor Irrigation Office at NSC, Aizawl West College, 200 bedded Hostel for Mizoram College of Nursing at Falkawn, DIET Buildings at Serchhip, Construction of Innovation Hub with 8M Dia Astronomy & Space Sciences Exposition Theatre for Sub Regional Science Centre at Aizawl, Taxation Office at Kolasib, Fire building at Kolasib have been completed. Many Staff Quarters, Police Stations and PHC buildings at various palces are also completed. Some College and Higher Secondary buildings are also completed.

Directorate Building of Health & Medical Education at NSC, Market Building at Vairengte, Judicial/ Court Buildings at some places are also under completion stage.

4. HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

As per last year record, a total of 1560 regular and 366 workcharged employees are working in the Department. This year is having a record of Regular Staff 2168, workcharged 391 and MR 991. It shows that record keeping is maintained better than last year.

- i) 17 new employees are recruited on co-terminus basis compared to last year of 28 employees,
- ii) 5 Officers and 47 Staff got promotion and upgradation of 5 Staff are attained,
- iii) Workcharged Staff of 54 and MR 7 are regularized,
- iv) 5 Officers got pension, 27 Staff and 20 Gr.D also got pension this year,
- v) 1 Officer and 25 Staff were expired compared to last year of 38 employees expired in total.

It is true to say that there is a continuous improvement and the works are steadily progressed.





Chapter 4

MISSION AND ROLE OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

The State PWD is divided into three functional zones, viz, Roads, Highways and Buildings. Each of the three zones is headed by Chief Engineer.

The Roads Zone is responsible for

- the efficient planning and delivery of road projects and programs on time, to agreed scope and budget; and
- efficient maintenance and development of all State roads (excepting the nominated projects and National Highways managed by the Highways zone and urban roads in Aizawl managed by the Buildings zone)

The Highways Zone is responsible for

- the efficient planning and delivery of major projects on time, to agreed scope and budget;
- efficient maintenance and development of State-managed National Highways; and
- efficient and effective management and utilisation of mechanical plant and equipment of the PWD in support of the road network.

The Buildings Zone is responsible for

- the efficient planning and design of Mizoram State Government buildings to safely and efficiently meet the functional requirements of the occupant and the Departments;
- construction and maintenance of Mizoram State Government Buildings on time, to agreed scope and budget;
- development of standards for Mizoram State Government buildings, recognising appropriate national and international practices for design, construction and maintenance..

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Chapter 5

ACHIEVEMENTS ON ROAD SECTORS (Rural, District & City Roads)

Chief Engineer (Roads) is looking after all the constructions and maintenances of Roads in Rural Areas (outside of Aizawl City) excepting National Highways, Mizoram State Road Projects (MSRP) under World Bank Loan & ADB and Roads under Kolasib Division. On the other hand, Chief Engineer (Buildings) is looking after Aizawl City Roads.

Construction and maintenance of roads and bridges in the State are the main subjects of Public Works Department. Every effort has been made to provide good roads to the public users for all round development within the available fund.

II. MAINTENANCE:

The total road Length maintained by PWD i.e. other than National Highways is 4615.169 kms during 2016-17 out of which 2744.411 kms of surfaced roads and 1870.758 kms of un-surfaced roads including 105 Nos. of Bridges is funded from the State Budget. The State Fund is utilized mostly for Periodic Maintenance type like renovation/reconstruction of road crust, resurfacing, protection works, etc.

Maintenance of the roads includes items such as Jungle Clearance, patch repair, pot-hole repair, side drain cleaning, surface clearing, landslip clearance, repair of culverts and retaining walls. ^ 36.70 crores was provided for normal Maintenance of Roads during 2016-2017. Action Plan is made and divided into Part I, II, III & IV. They are used for maintaining the specific State Roads. The achievements on action plan may be summarized as below :


III. AIZAWL CITY ROADS ACHIEVEMENTS:







IV. ACHIEVEMENTS ON RURAL ROADS UNDER OTHER FUNDING AGENCIES:

The department has various sources of funding for construction of new roads, up gradation, improvement, etc. These sources of funding are the Normal State Budget, PMGSY, NEC, NABARD, NLCPR, ISC, CRF, etc. The achievements under these schemes of funding sources apart from State Plan and EAP are furnished as below:

1. PMGSY :

The Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), Central Government Direct Funding Scheme, was launched in 2000 AD. It is a project which is popularly known as Village Connectivity with the objective of providing all weather roads to all unconnected Villages having population of 250 and above and is implemented under proper pre-determined programme. The villages to be connected are prioritized accordingly in Mizoram out of the Village population.

IIT, Kharagpur has developed a new technology for low cost cement concrete (CC) road construction, known as *Cell Filled Concrete Pavement* which has proved to be suitable in place of conventional CC roads for low volume traffic. Even though the initial cost of flexible-concrete road is high compared to cost of conventional flexible pavement, the life cycle cost with maintenance costs over a period of 10-20 years is less to the conventional one. The technology consists of placing a form work of plastic cells

150 x 150 mm and 100 mm deep over prepared foundation of road and placing zero slump concrete in the cells and compacting with road roller / platecompactor / earth rammer.

Trends & Updated Status of PMGSY in Mizoram:

As per Census record of 1991, there are 795 habitations out of which 363 villages are unconnected by all-weather road. Again out of these 364 villages, 253 villages are entitled to be included in this scheme as per norms. Break-up of these villages in population wise is as under:-

(A habitation less than 250 population en-route is also considered under this Scheme and is termed as 'incidental')

PMGSY is a 100% Centrally Sponsored Scheme but maintenance is to be borne by the State Government. The Central Government directly credited the sanction in the accounts of the Chief Executive Officer, Mizoram Rural Roads Development Agency (MiRRDA) at the State Bank of India, Aizawl. However, from 2015-2016, the funding pattern has been revised by Government of India as 90:10 ratio. Hence, Government of the Mizoram has so far sanctioned Rs. 1.60 crore towards SMS during 2015-16. Thus the amount of sanction and Fund received upto date is as follows:-

During the year 2015-16, 10 (ten) road projects for a length of 135.80 Kms have been completed benefitting 10 (ten) nos. of habitation out of which 4 (four) habitations are connected by all-weather road.



5. Inter State Road Connectivity (ISC) :

<u>Scope of the work for CRF and EI&ISC</u>: The works that can be considered under Central Road Fund (CRF) scheme and Economic Importance & Inter State Connectivity (EI&ISC) scheme as per notification of Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MORTH), Govt. of India are –

i) Construction of missing bridges, cross drainage works, rehabilitation of bridges, widening of twolanes, strengthening of weak pavement sections.

ii) Engineering aspects of road safety works covering improvement of traffic junction, road marking, signaling, construction of subways and over bridges, construction of parking lay-byes, bus sheds and the like.

iii) Construction of bypasses, parallel service roads along national highways or State highways, in built-up areas in exceptional cases and

iv) Development of connecting roads to national highways from rural roads as well as to tourist importance places.







Chapter 6

ACHIEVEMENTS ON HIGHWAY SECTOR

INTRODUCTION: Chief Engineer, PWD, Highways, Mizoram is looking after the National Highways entrusted to Mizoram, PWD. The total length of National Highways entrusted to Mizoram PWD is 1414.318 km.

Apart from the normal works of National Highways under its control, construction of 90.82 km length of road on NH-502A under Kaladan Multi Modal Transit Transport project is being taken up.

The following list of National Highways is entrusted to Mizoram, PWD:

- 1. <u>NH-54 (Lailapur-Tuipang)</u>: The NH-54 in Mizoram starts from Lailapur at 40.30Kmp upto 562.00Kmp at Tuipang, Silchar being the zero point . The road passes through many villages and towns, starting from the Northern end of Mizoram and travelling all through the State in the central part of Mizoram and ends in the southern end of the State. After reduction of road from Silchar to Lailapur is 40.30 kms. *The road between Lailapur to Tuipang is 522.00 kms to be undertaken by State PWD*.
- 2. <u>NH-54 'A' (Hrangchalkawn-Lunglei)</u>: The NH-54 'A' takes off from Hrangchalkawn of NH-54 in Mizoram upto Lunglei in the South. *The total length of the NH-54 'A' in Mizoram is 8.50 kms*.
- 3. <u>NH-54 'B' (Zero Point-Saiha)</u>: The NH-54 'B' takes of from Zero point (122.00 kmp from Lunglei Town) of NH-54 in Mizoram upto Saiha in the south. *The total length of the NH-54 'B' is 27.380 kms*.
- 4. <u>NH-154 (Bilkhawthlir-Bairabilui)</u>: The NH-154 in Mizoram takes off from NH-44 at Panchgram in Assam and connects NH-54 at Bilkhawthlir in Mizoram. The total length of the NH-154 is 147.00 km. Of which 89.00 kms is in Assam and *the remaining length of 58.00 kms is within Mizoram*. The road passes through as many as 6 villages or towns in the Mizoram State.
- 5. <u>NH-150 (NH-54 near Phaibawk-Sesawng-N. Vervek-Tuivai)</u>: The NH-150 takes off from NH-54 near Seling at 38.00 kms and runs northwards connecting Manipur at Tipaimukh (R.Tuivai). *The length of the NH in Mizoram is 140.00 km and passes through as many as 12 villages or towns*.
- 6. <u>NH-44A (Sairang-Langkaih</u>: The NH-44A is bifurcated out from the existing NH-54 near Sairang village at about 19.00 kms from Aizawl and runs westward connecting Manu in Tripura. *The total length of the NH-44A in Mizoram is 114.618 km*. The road passes through as many as 11 villages or towns.
- 7. **NH-502A KMMTTP (Lawngtlai-Zocha River) : (Kaladan Multi Modal Transit Transport Project**: The proposed Project Road takes off from 473.20kmp of NH-54 at Lawngtlai Town, running towards Southern direction up to R.Zocha (Indo-Myanmar border). The alignment of the Project road mostly follows the hill ranges that run in the north-south direction, passes through frequently cultivated jhum lands in majority of the project corridor. It crosses Lawngtlai Diltlang Parva (LDP) Road which runs towards south-west from Lawngtlai town up to Parva village near the Lawngtlai town at Chainage 4.600 Km. It also crosses Nalkawn Chamdur Valley (NCV) road. These two roads are the important economic and agricultural link roads of the area. The project road also passes through two villages, viz., Saizawh East and Zochachhuah. *The length of the road is 90.82 Km*.

- 8. <u>NH-102B (Keifang-Saichal-Ngopa-Tuivai)</u>: The NH-102B is a newly declared National Highway vide Gazette notification No. S.O. 395(E) Dated the 7th March, 2012 and is entrusted to the State Government vide Gazette notification No. 548(E) Dated the 17th Febuary, 2015. The National Highway takes of from Keifang of NH-54 in Mizoram upto Manipur Border through Tuivai. *The total length of the NH-102B is 109.00 kms*.
- 9. <u>NH-302 (Lunglei-Tlabung-Tlabung(Kawrpuichhuah))</u>: The NH-302 is a newly declared National Highway vide Gazette notification No. S.O. 839(E) Dated the 4th March, 2014 and is entrusted to the State Government vide Gazette notification No.548(E) Dated the 17th Febuary, 2015. The National Highway starts from Lunglei and terminates at Tlabung (Kawrpuichhuah). *The total length of the NH-302 is 94.00 kms*.
- 10. <u>NH-306A (Vairengte-Zohmun-New Vervek)</u>: The NH-320A is a newly declared National Highway vide Gazette Notification No. S.O. 2232(E) Dated the ^{5th} Sept.2014 and is entrusted to the State Government vide Gazette notification No.548 (E) Dated the 17thFebuary, 2015. The National Highway takes off from Vairengte of NH-54 in Mizoram upto New Vervek via Saiphai and Zohmun. *The total length of the NH-306A is 100.00 kms*.
- 11. <u>NH-6 (Seling-Champhai-Zokhawthar)</u>: The NH-6 is a newly declared National Highway vide Gazette notification No. S.O. 839(E) Dated the 4th March,2014 and is entrusted to the State Government vide Gazette notification No.548(E) Dated the 17th Febuary, 2015.The National Highway takes of from Seling of NH-54 in Mizoram upto Champhai (Zokhawthar). *The total length of the NH-6 is 150.00 kms*.



Chapter 7

ACHIEVEMENTS ON BUILDING SECTOR

1.0 INTRODUCTION :

Public Works Department is not only concerned with the construction and maintenance of roads, but is also entrusted with the responsibilities of construction and maintenance of State Government Buildings in Mizoram. These Government Buildings are mainly Public Buildings (Government Offices, sports infrastructures, community buildings, market buildings, education buildings etc.,) and Residential Buildings (Staff Quarters). The funding for construction of such buildings mainly comes from the State Plan, NEC, NLCPR and other Centrally Sponsored Schemes. However, fund for their maintenance is met from State-owned resources which are very limited.

2.0 ORGANISATIONAL SET-UP :

The Chief Engineer (*Buildings*), as stated above, is responsible for the construction of new buildings and maintenance of the existing Government buildings within and outside the state of Mizoram. In addition, maintenance of roads within Aizawl City is also entrusted to the Chief Engineer (*Buildings*).

In the main office, the Chief Engineer (Buildings) is assisted in planning and monitoring by a Superintending Engineer (Planning & Works), Executive Engineer (Planning & Works), Executive Engineer (Design & Research) with supporting technical officers and staffs. In addition, there are Account staffs (headed by Finance & Accounts Officer) and Ministerial Staff (headed by Deputy Director of Administration) to assist the Chief Engineer in Financial Control and Administration.

To execute the Architectural Drawings (prepared by Chief Architect's Office of the Engineer-in-Chief's Office) and the Structural Drawings (prepared by the Design Cell of the Chief Engineer (Buildings) Office), there is a working circle, namely Project Circle, with its office at Treasury Square and headed by a Superintending Engineer, assisted by four (4) Working Divisions.

Chief Engineer (*Buildings*) also takes care of Maintenance of Government Buildings constructed by PWD within and outside the state of Mizoram and maintenance of roads within Aizawl City This task is headed by the Superintending Engineer, Building Circle assisted by three working Divisions.

The Executive Engineer, Buildings Division look after the maintenance of P.W.D. constructed buildings within Aizawl and the 2(two) road Divisions under Building Circle are entrusted with Maintenance of Roads within Aizawl city.

In connection with the tasks entrusted to the Chief Engineer (*Buildings*), there are two specialised jobs wherein specialised line of engineering is required i.e. Electrical and Mechanical Engineering for which one Working Circle, namely Mechanical Circle functions with its headquarters at Laipuitlang, Aizawl. All buildings constructed and maintained by the Project Circle and Building Circle requires Electrical Engineers for internal wiring and their maintenance for which there are two working Electrical Divisions. Under the same Circle, there is one Mechanical Division to look after the repair and maintenance of Departmental Heavy Machineries and Equipments in Roads and Buildings works.

1. MIZORAM STATE ROADS II REGIONAL TRANSPORT CONNECTIVITY PROJECT (MSR II-RTCP)

1. INTRODUCTION:

The Mizoram State Roads II Regional Transport Connectivity Project aims to provide better intrastate and regional connectivity for the residents of landlocked Mizoram with Myanmar, Bangladesh and N.E. India.

2. PROJECT COST and FINANCING:

The Project's total cost is estimated at US \$107 million which is financed through the World Bank's International Development Association (IDA) funds from the Country envelope and the Regional IDA envelope. The Loan Agreement is also signed between DEA, Min. of Finance, World Bank and Govt. of Mizoram on Dt. 28th August 2014 and is effective from 10.10.2014.

The State Govt. has to bear expenditures for all pre-construction activities i.e. LA, R&R, Utility lines shifting and charges for Forest Clearances.

3. **PROJECT ROADS (2-lane, 12m road width)**

MSR II-RTCP has 2 (two) components to support the Project development objectives, namely:-<u>I. Component A</u>: Improvement of Priority cross-border roads and trade related infrastructure, which include:-

II. Component B :

Road Sector Modernization and Performance Enhancement through Institutional Strengthening.

This component supports gradual transformation of PWD into a modern road agency through implementation of a Road Sector Modernization Plan (RSMP) which will carry forward and deepen various institutional development initiatives introduced under the MSRP I. The RSMP activities are periodically reviewed and modified during project implementation and mainly focus on:

- i) Modernization of policies, engineering practices, and business procedures.
- ii) Asset management and maintenance.
- iii) Institutional and Human Resource Development.
- iv) Road Safety Management.
- v) Improved Environmental and Social safeguards capacity and management

For implementation of the RSMP activities, RSMP - Working Group Committee chaired by the Engineer-in-Chief, PWD was formed on 7th May, 2015 with 10 members in the Committee. For effective implementation of the activities, 5 RSMP – Sub Group Committees were again formed with each Sub-Groups having specific tasks.

Under the RSMP activities, installation of Video Conferencing system in E-in-C Mini Conference Room and distribution of Video Conferencing hardware facilities in 17 PWD Offices have already been carried out while several activities are still more to come for implementation.

2. ADB ASSISTED SERCHHIP-BUARPUI ROAD UNDER PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION UNIT (PIU) :

INTRODUCTION:

Asian Development Bank (ADB) is assisting Government of India through a programme of work called North Eastern State Roads Investment Program (NESRIP) which is a part of Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (MDONER) initiative to bring the North Eastern Region into the mainstream of development. Mizoram is one of such North Eastern States selected to receive ADB assistance and under which the existing road between Serchhip to Buarpui Road i.e Thenzawl is included under Tranche-2 for improvement and upgradation to an **Intermediate Lane**.

The project has been divided into two parts – Part I: Serchhip to Thenzawl (15.20 kms) and Part II: Thenzawl to Buarpui (39.80 kms).

In total, the project entails improvement and up-gradation of 55 km of existing road.

PROJECT COST AND FINANCING:

The project total cost sanctioned by MDoNER, GoI is Rs. 167.9 Crore which is financed through MDoNER by ADB. Sanction was accorded on 23rd Sept, 2011.

The loan agreement was signed between ADB and GoI on 17th Feb, 2014 which was effective from 20th May, 2014.

Due to late signing of loan agreement between ADB and GoI, and various deficiencies in DPR prepared by SMEC International Pvt. Ltd., Gurgaon, Haryana during 2008-2009, the 5th National Level Steering Committee on North Eastern State Roads Investment Programme (NESRIP) held on 17th February 2016 decided the revised DPR be submitted for re-consideration by Cabinet Committee on Economic Affair (CCEA). Accordingly, revised cost estimate amounting to Rs. 272.50 Crore have been submitted to MDoNER, GoI for further action.


FINANCIAL STATEMENTS


