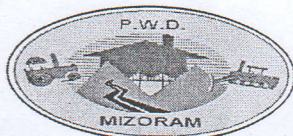

CIRCULAR

Dated Aizawl, the 29th June, 2015.

No. F.21011/2/2011-PW : In order to avoid duplicity of works in various Offices under Public Works Department, following practices should be carried out with immediate effect and until further orders:-

1. Regarding local tour i.e. within the State of Mizoram -

- a) Engineer-in-Chief will have to obtain prior approval of the Government i.e. Principal Secretary, PWD;
- b) Chief Engineers and Chief Architect will have to obtain prior approval of Engineer-in-Chief, PWD;
- c) Superintending Engineers will have to obtain prior approval of his concerned Chief Engineer, PWD;
- d) Senior Architects, Architects and Assistant Architects will have to obtain prior approval of Chief Architect, PWD;
- e) Executive Engineers will have to obtain prior approval of his/her concerned Superintending Engineer, PWD; and
- f) Sub-Divisional Officers will have to obtain prior approval of his/her concerned Executive Engineer, PWD.

2. Regarding all tours outside the State, the present practices will be continued. It is also re-iterated that some Officers of PWD are in the habit of giving a copy of their tour programme to the Government i.e. Principal Secretary, PWD which will, hence forth, be stopped and only tour programme forwarded by Engineer-in-Chief, PWD will be entertained by the Government.
