The Government of India has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Mizoram State Roads II – Regional Transport Connectivity Project (MSR II –RTCP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) aim at discovering the capacity needs of local contractors in the road, bridge and building sector of the constructions industry in Mizoram which is expected to play a pivotal role in the development of the state and national economy, and therefore needs to be sustained. Sustainable capacity needs are required to be built through the strengthening of the local contractors and other stakeholders in the industry without prejudice to their foreign counterparts. Recommendations have to be made for contractors’ capacity to be built in the areas of site supervision, administration of construction works, project management techniques, negotiation techniques for claims, leadership skills, etc.

The Mizoram Public Works Department now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The short listing criteria are:

1. Business objective and expertise of the firm;
2. Corporate capacity of the Firm (annual turnover, financial information for past 5 years);
3. General work experiences of the firm (with documentary evidence)
4. Similar work experiences of the firm, its complexity and similar geographical experiences
 - i. Experience in carrying out studies of similar magnitude in the past five years with documentary evidence
 - ii. Experience in carrying out studies and surveys in North Eastern India, preferably in Mizoram (with documentary evidence)
 - iii. Experience in carrying out studies and surveys for Government of India / State Government Ministries or Departments in the past five years (with documentary evidence)
5. A list of key professional persons with qualification and experiences association with firm;

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers [January 2011]* (“Consultant Guidelines”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
