Minimum bachelor’s degree in Civil Engineering and Master’s degree in a highway or civil engineering or related discipline.
2. General work experience of the Consultant (with documentary evidence)
3. Specific experience of the Consultant, its complexity and similar geographical experiences
 - i. Experience as experiences as Team leader/ Senior Highway engineer in the field of design and construction of highways and roads (with documentary evidence)
 - ii. Experiences in the field of mountainous road design and construction (with documentary evidence)
 - iii. Experiences in the civil engineering infrastructure / road works funded through bilateral and multilateral agencies (with documentary evidence)
 - iv. Experience in conducting technical review/audit.
 - v. Experience of working in hilly areas
4. Proficiency in English and ability to operate Microsoft project, Microsoft Office and mobile applications.


